### “G2” COALITION NETWORK: COALITION GOALS”

1. Identify the “**core group**”.
2. Commit to **one meeting a month**, one hour minimum.
3. Meet at a **local church** if at all possible (with support from the Pastor or leadership).
4. Develop **two email mailings lists**: one for the “core group” and one that also includes “all interested people” (those that are not committed yet, but want to be kept apprised of progress).
5. Identify the local “**Reentry Champion**” who will provide leadership.
6. Eventually develop a “**leadership team**” (like a working Board, but not that formal, in most cases).
7. Finalize the “Local Reentry **Resource List**”.
8. Post it at the local **Community Action Agency** office.
9. Host (or help to co-sponsor) a local or regional **Reentry Conference** once a year.
10. Participate in the annual OPSR Oklahoma Reentry Coalition **Leaders Summit** once a year.
11. Evolve to the point where you can provide “**a single point of contact**” for returning citizens in your community.
12. Become a full-blown “chapter” of OPSR (which is still in the “design” phase).
13. Help to oversee a local “reentry chapter” in the ODOC prison nearest your location. These are inmate-led groups, who require a volunteer sponsor in order to function.
14. Eventually help start the “**Reentry Council**” for your area, made up community leaders, like the mayor’s office, the Sheriff, the Police department, the DA’s office, the public defender’s office, WorkForce, etc. This group would “set policy” for successful reentry (and criminal justice reform in general) in your area.
15. Work together, and hopefully include the local Ministerial Alliance, to have at least one “**certified prison aftercare facility**” (transitional home or other housing ministry) and one “**certified prison aftercare church**” in your community.
